The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF CERTAIN CIVIL WAR INFANTRY REGIMENTS DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15 NNNN the following 2 sections:—

Section 15 OOOO. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside June 27 as the 9th Regiment Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry of the Civil War Day and recommending that said day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.

Section 15 PPPP. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside July 18 as the 54th Regiment Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry of the Civil War Day and recommending that said day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
