### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Three.

#### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, if the Town of Bridgewater purchases the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional High School from the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional School District, said town shall be eligible for the reimbursement percentage rate from the Commonwealth contained in Chapter 159 of the Acts of 2000.

SECTION 2. The District may sell and convey any and all interest in the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional High School to the Town of Bridgewater. The town shall be eligible for the reimbursement percentage contained in Chapter 159 of the Acts of 2000 for the costs of the purchase and appraisal which shall be subject to the review and approval of the Inspector General. The review shall include an examination of the methodology used for the appraisal. The Inspector General shall prepare a report of his review and file the report with the Commissioner of Education, the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means and the Joint Committee on State Administration.

SECTION 3. The monies paid by said town to the District for the purchase of the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional High School shall be placed in a capital account and used for the purchase of land for a school building, the costs of renovation and construction of school buildings for the benefit of school age children in the Town of Raynham.
